





- WP7 Organizations: Identification of 1 Leader and 5 members for WP7 per subnetwork, the list has to be reviewed regularly







# Results of Survey on training and education 9 April MetabERN meeting






## **Capacity building : Name of the programme**

- Teleconference on 4 April 2018 with associations of patients: to have their opinion about this programmme


## Survey on: Mutidisciplinary approach around patients stories




### **Evaluation of the website visit**
